Spatial Guidelines



Distancing

Government guidelines state that distancing needs to remain between 6ft/2m between workspaces, meetings, canteen areas & lounge spaces

Meetings

For meetings with 5+ members should be carried out in open spaces. Using moveable and flexible furniture or screens, create open meeting spaces and boundaries



Reconfigure layout

Rearrange your workspace with existing furniture were possible

Owned Spaces

Reduce/eliminate shared desking and try to switch to own spaces. Elimination of hot-desking





Desking

Separate desking for your staff if you have the space to accommodate. Bench desking can be reconfigured to become individual work stations

Increased screen height

When space is limited, adding height with sneeze screens to existing desktop screens and including screens between staff can help reduce exposure.




Add space division

Use moveable screens to create barriers. Get creative by using storage furniture and plants as partitions.

Communal areas

Reduce the guest seating in reception areas and introduce individual seating in communal areas

Floor Plan Considerations



Floor Plan Considerations

- Larger desks to ensure social distance is maintained
- Positioning of desks to be towards the outerparameters of the room to maximise the use of space
- Position pedestals to the centre of the desks to minimise the movement of the staff and increase the space between colleagues
- Opt for cubicles rather than bench desking
- Adding sneeze screens to all desks or moveable free standing screens to create meeting spaces or clear divisions between desks/departments




